
Smart Interview on Demand

New feature: Workplace skills score in China - With the new Azure service implemented, the scores for workplace skills will be available in China. The questions for Workplace Skills scoring are now available on the client-admin platform. The recruiter can add these questions to their interview question set and enable workplace scores for the VI test. The Al model for workplace skills will evaluate the candidate's response on behavioural skills required for a job role.

Coding & Simulations

1. New Feature: Demo video/quick tour now added to Automata SQL

- A short tour has been added to Automata SQL (as in Automata) to give the candidate a brief overview of the platform and how it works. This tour will be shown when the candidate lands on the Automata SQL assessment interface.
- The demo will start as soon as the candidate clicks on "Start Demo" and can be skipped.





2. Improvement: Copy paste query allowed in Automata SQL

• Candidates can now copy and paste the queries in Automata SQL editor (as in Automata). This will be beneficial for candidates writing queries in their local systems and copying them to our editor.

3. Improvement: Automata subsections score now available in standard excel

 We have enabled the Automata subsection in standard excel of Automata and the subsection scores will be reflected in this. These subsections are added on both question level and overall level. The following columns will now be shown in standard excel in addition to the previous ones:

Overall Level

- i. Module Name: Programming Ability (subsection)
- ii. Module Name: Functional Correctness (subsection)
- iii. Module Name: Programming Practices (subsection)

Question Level

- i. Module Name/ Question 'n': Programming Ability
- ii. Module Name/ Question 'n': Functional Correctness
- iii. Module Name/ Question 'n': Programming Practices

4. Programming languages count increased in *SIL/SILC*. (to be released by 21st Oct)

Support of 6 more languages will now be extended to SIL/SILC by the end of this month. The languages which will be made available in addition to the previous ones are C++14, Java 7, Java 11, Python 3.7, Pike, HY, Rhino.







- 1. Improvement: Change in the filter icon placement
 - The filter icon will be available right above the candidate listing grid.
 - Every time a filter is applied, the client can view the applied filter information next to the filter icon



- Date filters will reflect the count of days in that range (including the to and from dates)
- To reflect filters such as Scheduled by, Status and Assessments, we will show the number of values selected.

Tooltip message to be added on the filter icon saying "Filter is applied on advance search"





• Different statuses will now be visible under the link 'Status Key'. A drop down will appear by placing the cursor on status key.
